



## 2022-23 CLC Health & Safety Plan

### Goals

1. Create responsive and adaptable mitigation strategies based upon current levels of local COVID transmission.
2. Maintain some attendance flexibility that provides for synchronous remote learning as needed when students are not feeling well.

### Mitigation Strategies

- Daily screening questions will be administered to all individuals entering the facility.
- Individuals with COVID-19 symptoms of illness will be required to stay home. (See [Send to School Decision Chart](#) for details.)
- Proper hand washing will be reinforced and hand sanitizer will be readily available.
- Ventilation will be enhanced through use of window fans as weather allows.
- Outdoor space will be used frequently.
- Contact tracing will be implemented in collaboration with State and local health departments.
- CDC guidelines will be followed for symptomatic individuals and close contacts.
- Students may participate in synchronous remote instruction for up to 5 school days.
- Accommodations will be made for individuals with medical complications upon request.
- Classrooms and bathrooms will be sanitized daily.
- Weekly indoor masking recommendations will be based upon [Centre County's Community Level designation](#) on Friday of the previous week. When Centre County is in Low or Medium Community Level according to the CDC [1], masks will be optional. When Centre County is at High Level, masks will be highly recommended. Special circumstances like large gatherings or classroom outbreaks (3 or more connected COVID cases) at High COVID levels may require temporary mandated masking on a case-by-case basis.
- Masking will be optional outdoors.
